

3-5 years

Every child should have an enlightenment period where they are interested in drawing and experimenting with materials. Open to young children who like to doodle and have a desire to express their ideas.

Class Objectives

Guiding and inspiring students through thematic contents, lean and engage in creative activities

- 1.5 hours per week to complete a small piece of work on a related theme that is simple and easy for children.
- Themes are unique. Teacher will provide reasonable guidance to encourage children to doodle, and use abstract form to express the figurative form.
- No pressure on children. The cultivation of drawing interests is the main focus, and children will have more freedom for expression.
- Teacher will patiently accompany the children, creating a sense of security while they are drawing.
- The teaching pace is relatively slow, allowing children more time and space to engage with art.
- Develop children's patience and perseverance.

Class Objectives | Acrylic Painting

The summer course primarily focuses on teaching acrylic painting techniques and is the favorite painting class among children

- Each class lasts 1.5 hours, with a new theme introduced every two weeks and a painting completed every two weeks.
- The course aims to delight children during their colorsensitive period and cultivate their understanding of basic colors.
- Through four different thematic directions, children are guided to learn painting techniques, covering color coordination, blending, brushwork, and gradients. While experiencing the joy of colors, they will learn to use colors to create their own worlds.
- The studio maintains strict standards to ensure each student's work is completed satisfactorily and to prevent chaos. Art is not only enjoyable but also requires perseverance and a determined mindset.


